Fellowships

Purpose: To assist in developing faculties in Canadian business schools, and highly qualified personnel for Canadian business.

No. offered: 28 Fellowships annually.

Value: Doctoral—Can\$5,000; Master's—Can\$2,000; Undergraduate—Can\$1,000. The money is given to the university who may use it to assist more than one student if they wish.

Tenable for the final year of a course, as follows: Doctoral—Universities of British Columbia, Western Ontario, Toronto, York, Queen's University, Simon Fraser University and Laval University; Master's—Universities of Alberta, Ottawa, Sherbrooke, Saskatchewan, Windsor, and Manitoba, École des Hautes Études Commerciales, and Dalhousie, McMaster, St. Mary's, Queens, and McGill Universities; Under-

graduate—Universities of Prince Edward Island, Western Ontario, Calgary, New Brunswick and Quebec, Carleton University, Memorial University of Newfoundland, Lakehead University and Ryerson Polytechnical Institute.

Eligibility: Open to Canadian citizens or students with landed immigrant status. As the Fellowships are administered by the individual universities, they are awarded in accordance with their regular award procedures on the basis of academic achievement and need.

Note: An additional doctoral Fellowship is offered at Guelph University in the field of water quality.

Candidates should apply to the relevant university for all information concerning the Fellowships, and applications must be made direct to the university.
