- Quellada. Topical treatment for scabies and lice: see **Gamma-benzene hexachloride**
- Questran. For hypercholesterolaemia: see **Cholestyramine**.
- Quicksol. Purified crystalline beef insulin: see **Insulin**.
- Quinicardine. Antidysrhythmic: see **Quinidine**.
- Quinoderm. Topical treatment for acne: see **Benzoyl peroxide, Hydroxyquinoline**.
- Quinoderm with 1 percent hydrocortisone. As Quinoderm plus **Hydrocortisone**.
- Quinoped. Topical antifungal for feet: see **Benzoyl peroxide, Hydroxyquinoline**.

R

- Rabro. Antacid: see **Bismuth subnitrate, Calcium carbonate, Frangula, Liquorice, Magnesium oxide**.
- Rapifen (c). Narcotic analgesic: see **Alfentanil**.
- Rapitard. Long-acting mixture of purified beef and pork insulins: see **Insulin**.
- Rastinon. Hypoglycaemic: see **Tolbutamide**.
- Raudixin (d). Antihypertensive: see **Rauwolfia**.
- Rautrax. Antihypertensive. As Raudixin plus **Hydroflumethiazide, Potassium chloride**.
- Rautrax Sine K. Antihypertensive. As Rautrax but no potassium chloride.
- Rauwiloid. Antihypertensive: see **Rauwolfia**.
- Rauwiloid + Veriloid. Antihypertensive: see **Rauwolfia, Veratrum**.
- Razoxin. Antitumour: see **Razoxane**.
- Reactivan. CNS stimulant and vitamins for tonic: see **Aneurine, Cyanocobalamin, Fencamfamin, Pyridoxine, Vitamin C**.
- Redeptin. Depot injection tranquillizers/anti-psychotic: see **Fluspirilene**.
- Redoxon. Vitamin: see **Vitamin C**.
- Regulan. Purgative: see **Ispaghula**.
- Rehibin. For anovulatory infertility: see **Cyclofenil**.
- Rehidrat. Electrolytes and sugars supplied in a powder for reconstitution into solution. Used orally to correct fluid and electrolyte imbalance (e.g. due to diarrhoea and vomiting).
- Relaxit. Enema for constipation: see **Glycerol, Sodium citrate, Sodium lauryl sulphate, Sorbic acid**.
- Relefact LH-RH. For diagnostic use in delayed sexual development and failure of pituitary gland function: see **Gonadorelin**.
- Remiderm (d). Topical corticosteroid/anti-infective: see **Halquinol, Triamcinolone**.
- Remnos. Hypnotic: see **Nitrazepam**.
