**Yale lock.** A common brand of CYLINDER LOCK.

**Yankee gutter.** (*USA* See ARRIS GUTTER.

**yard.** An area of ground enclosed by buildings or fences. It may be used for the storage of building materials.

**yard gulley.** See GULLEY.

**yard lumber.** (*USA*) LUMBER intended for light framing and finish work.

**yard trap.** See GULLEY.

**Y-branch.** See WYE BRANCH.

**year ring.** See ANNUAL RING.

**YG.** *abbr.* Yard gulley. See GULLEY.

**yield point** (yield stress). The STRESS at which a component under tensile load begins to elongate without increase in load.

**yoke.** Timber or steel members fixed around the FORMWORK for a column or beam.

**Yorkshire bond.** See MONK BOND.

**Young's modulus.** See ELASTIC MODULUS.

**Y-value.** See ADMITTANCE.
