Acne vulgaris

- A. Comedones are the hallmark clinical feature of acne: open comedones (black heads) and closed comedones (white heads)
- B. No comedones are seen in acne rosacea
- C. Lesions occur on the face, ears, chest, back, neck, and upper arms
