

## Lichen Simplex Chronicus

- A. Secondary to chronic, habitual rubbing and scratching
- B. Well-defined, hyperpigmented to erythematous, leathery plaques with exaggerated skin lines (lichenification)
- C. Posterior neck, extensor arms and legs, genitalia
