Progestogens in Non-gynecological Indications

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H.J.A. Carp (ed.), *Progestogens in Obstetrics and Gynecology*,
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The last sentence on page 198 “The serum levels of progesterone, estradiol, testosterone, DHEA-S and noradrenalin decreased into the normal range according to the Tanner classification [54].” should be replaced with following sentence:

The serum levels of progesterone, estradiol, testosterone, DHEA-S and noradrenalin increased in patients with ADD into the normal range according to the Tanner classification [52]. In patients with ADHD however, noradrenalin is decreased into the normal range, whereas progesterone, estradiol, testosterone and DHEA-S is, as in the ADD-patients, increased into the normal range.
