

# Retigabine

<b>Ethanol</b>	Ethanol can increase mean retigabine Cmax and AUC values by 36 % and 23 %, respectively [1]
<b>Oral contraceptives</b>	Oral contraceptives do not affect the pharmacokinetics of retigabine [2]
