

Sulthiame

<i>Antacids</i>	Antacids containing magnesium trisilicate can decrease the oral bioavailability of sulthiame by up to 73 %, while antacids containing bismuth oxycarbonate and magnesium oxide can decrease the oral bioavailability of sulthiame by <15 %. To avoid problems, administration of sulthiame and antacids should be separated by at least 2 h [1]
