The chapter: "Eastern Greater Caucasus" has been retracted following the conclusion of an investigation by Vakhushti Bagrationi Institute of Geography, Ivane Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University. The institution concluded that the book contains translated material that substantially overlaps with the following works (amongst others) Khazaradze R, The Pleistocene Glaciation of Caucasus. Metsniereba; 2014. Tbilisi, Georgia; Gobejishvili R, The relief Georgia. Universali; 2011. Tbilisi, Georgia; Georgian National Atlas (Ed. Ramir C bejishvili), 2012, Tbilisi, Georgia The Latitution also raised concerns about authorship and author affiliations within the book and if formed us that co-authors Alexander Javakhishvili, Davit Tsereteli, Levan Maruashvili Ramın Gobejishvili, and Nikoloz Astakhov are deceased.
