on its almost purely oceanic distribution, suggested that it was the larva of an abyssal enteropneust. Damas and Stiasny (1961) had also concluded that the parent of *P. pelagica* lived at great depth.

This giant larva is here reported from the Pacific Ocean. Because the Pacific Ocean specimens have not been compared with type material by the authors, and because the taxon *Planctosphaera pelagica* is applied to a larva and not an adult, we use the term "planctosphaera" in this paper as a common name and not as a technical taxon.
