DR ANGUS ALEXANDER MACMILLAN, 1915-1959

THE DEATH of Dr Angus Alexander MacMillan occurred in Vancouver, on Tuesday, June 23, 1959. Dr MacMillan was born in Guelph, Ontario, and was a graduate of Queen's University, 1941. Following internship at the Ottawa Civic Hospital, Dr MacMillan served in the R C N (R) from 1942 to 1946. He began his postgraduate training in anaesthesia at the Royal Victoria Hospital, Montreal, and completed his training at the Vancouver General Hospital, receiving his certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons in 1950.

Dr MacMillan was a senior partner of Associated Anaesthetic Services, Vancouver and a member of the Attending Staff of the Vancouver General Hospital, the Vancouver Children's Hospital, and the teaching staff of the University of British Columbia. He was a member of the Canadian Medical Association, Canadian Anaesthetists' Society, and the American Society of Anaesthesiology.

"Gus," as he was affectionately called by his associates, was a devoted family man, and a strong, dedicated supporter of the United Church of Canada.

The Canadian Anaesthetists' Society has lost a valued member. Those of us who were associated with him in partnership have lost a capable, trusted, and sincere friend and partner.

To his widow, Laura, daughter Marian, and son Bruce, the members of the Canadian Anaesthetists' Society extend their deepest regrets.
