The selected candidate will have to execute a bond to serve the medical college (in which he is employed) for a period of two years after his return to India.

The selected candidate will be paid S. Frs. 2,000 (equivalent to approximately Rs. 3,500/- at the prevailing rate of exchange) per month. Traveling expenses from India to Basle and back have to be borne by the candidate himself.
