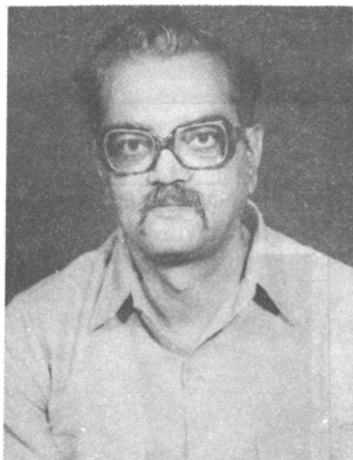

Dr. S. R. Kulkarni, a senior E. N. T. Surgeon from Kolhapur (Maharashtra) passed away on 24-3-93 at the age of 57 years.

He passed his M. S. (E. N. T.) from Bombay University in 1966 and started practice as an E. N. T. surgeon in Kolhapur in the same year.

He worked as a Hon. ENT surgeon in Kolhapur Corporation Hospital for many years.

He was keenly interested in the education of congenitally deaf children and did pioneering work in this field.

He started deaf mute school in Kolhapur for the first time.

He read many papers in this subject in different regional conferences.

He is survived by his wife who is a teacher for deaf and two sons.
