The Michael Höllwarth Clinical Research Prize was awarded to Dr. Anne Marie O'Donnell from Dublin for her presentation on "Abnormal Scn1b and Fxyd1 gene expression in the pulled through ganglionic colon may influence functional outcome in patients with Hirschsprung's disease".
