In the original publication, in Abstract, the sentence that reads as, “Oral S-1 at a dose of 80 mg/m² was..... drug-free interval” should read as, “Oral S-1 at a dose of 40 mg/m² was administered twice daily for 2 weeks, followed by a 1-week drug-free interval”.

In Patients and Methods, under the heading Treatment Plan, the sentence that reads as “Specifically,that did not exceed 40 mg/m² based on BSA as

follows—BSA < 1.25 m², 40 mg; BSA 1.25–1.5 m², 50 mg twice daily; and BSA > 1.5 m², 60 mg” should read as, “Specifically, the drug was administered orally twice daily for 14 consecutive days at a dose based on BSA as follows—BSA < 1.25 m², 40 mg; BSA 1.25–1.5 m², 50 mg; BSA ≥ 1.5 m², 60 mg”.
