The correct version of Fig. 1 is given below.

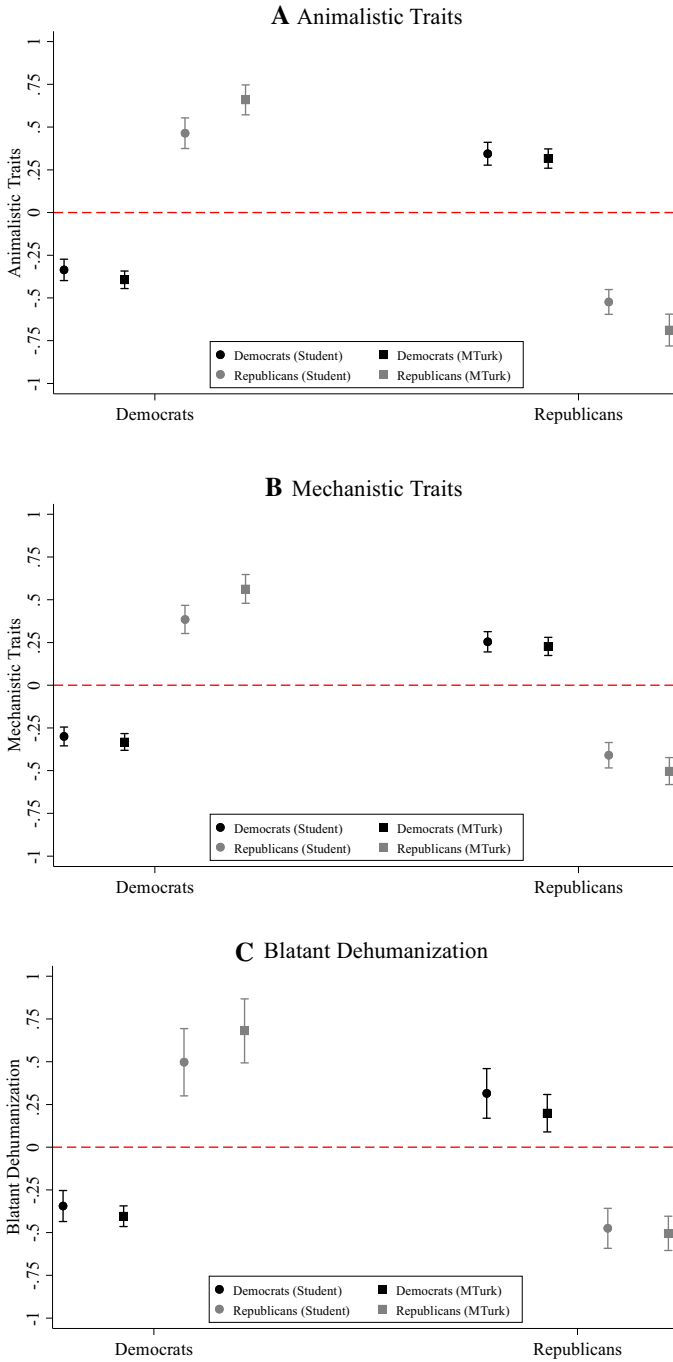
