Obituary

Philip L. Quinn (1940–2004)

It is with deep regret that I report the death of Philip Quinn, John A. O'Brien Professor of Philosophy at the University of Notre Dame, on November 13, 2004. Phil was one of the first persons who accepted my invitation to join the Board of Associate Editors of the International Journal for Philosophy of Religion in 1990. He was widely known for his work in the philosophy of science and the philosophy of religion, served as Editor of Faith and Philosophy and held significant leadership positions in the American Philosophical Association, including President of the Central Division and Chair of the National Board of Officers. Phil's published work is characterized by a deep sense of integrity, fairness and critical insight, and he brought these same qualities to his university and professional service, including his review of articles submitted to this journal. His reviews were written with the same care and precision that he applied to his own work. Even in cases where an article was not accepted for publication and Phil's review was sent anonymously to the author, I am confident that most responded with appreciation and thanks.
