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Article Explains ISO 9001 Revisions for Manufacturers

Following the latest update to the revision process for ISO 9001, the global Quality Management System (QMS) standard, Manufacturing.Net has recently published a conversation with LRQA's Senior Technical Manager for North America, Michael Harder, about what ISO issuing ISO/DIS 9001:2014 means for organizations.
