



## Correction to: Autonomy-induced preference, budget reallocation, and child health

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When we published this article, the Assumption 1 on page 4 contained an error: while the preceding paragraph stated:

Mother's autonomy or the degree of empowerment is captured by making the parameters of the utility function dependent on mother's autonomy coefficient  $\alpha$  such that  $0 \leq \alpha < 1$ . Specifically,  $\gamma = \gamma(\alpha)$  and  $\delta = \delta(\alpha)$  where  $0 < \gamma(\alpha) < 1$  and  $0 < \delta(\alpha) < 1$  are the utility elasticities with respect to  $H_C$  and  $G$ , respectively.

The following Assumption stated the contrary:

**Assumption 1**  $\gamma'(\alpha) > 0$  and  $\delta'(\alpha) > 0$

This mistake happened during typesetting and sadly remained unnoticed. Assumption 1 should read correctly:

**Assumption 1**  $\gamma'(\alpha) > 0$  and  $\delta'(\alpha) < 0$
