

## FURTHER READING

The list below provides a selection of English-language books and articles which provide a helpful starting point for further investigation into childhood, death and the emotions. It excludes demographic works charting mortality rates and only provides a few key works on infanticide, one topic where an extensive literature exists. Instead, it focuses on works that explore the emotional, cultural and social implications of child death and its representation.

Additional primary and secondary sources, including non-English language sources, for individual chapters can be found in the endnotes. There is inevitably some overlap in the themes; where more than one theme is represented by a text, it is listed by what we regard as the dominant subject of the work.

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
