María Rosa Zapatero Osorio completed her doctoral thesis at the Instituto de Astrofísica de Canarias (IAC) in 1997. Since then, she worked as a postdoctoral scientist at Caltech in California (USA) and at the Spanish National Institute of Aerospace Technology (INTA) in Spain. She obtained a permanent position at the IAC and later moved to the Centro de Astrobiología (CSIC-INTA) in Madrid in 2009. She was part of the team that discovered the first young brown dwarf in 1995 and led the discovery of the first isolated planetary-mass objects in sigma Orionis in 2000.
