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EDITORIAL NOTE

The Conference on Organic Conductors and Semiconductors was held at the resort of Siófok, Hungary from the 30th August to 3rd September 1976. It was sponsored by the Hungarian Academy of Sciences, the Central Research Institute for Physics and the Loránd Eötvös Physical Society. The main object of the conference was to bring together physicists and chemists from all parts of the world to discuss a field of rapidly growing importance: the physical and chemical properties of conducting organic materials. Although a number of papers dealt with the chemical aspects of the topic the main emphasis was on the physical properties. Nearly all papers dealt with quasi one-dimensional organic systems. The ordering of the papers follows that of the sessions of the Conference itself. Abstracts have been included of lectures where no full text was submitted.

We should like to point out that the camera-ready technique has been used in the production of this volume as this ensures rapid publication. Thus, editorial work has been limited to the correction of those misprints which might otherwise have interfered with the meaning. Illustrations have been reproduced in the form submitted.

We should like to express our thanks to the contributors for their cooperation in sending their manuscripts without delay.

This Editorial Note provides us with the opportunity of expressing thanks to the Organizing Committee and to all others concerned with arrangements which enabled the smooth running of the Conference.
